

new change for mobile deposits

Since the beginning of July 1, 2018, checks that are deposited via mobile deposit must be endorsed as "For Mobile Deposit at FMB Berlin."

Why you may ask? The Federal Reserve has implemented this change to protect consumers from cases of duplicate check presentment. To avoid possible rejection, make sure to have the written endorsement of "For Mobile Deposit at FMB Berlin" as customers are no longer able to check the box that appears on the back as a form of endorsment.


We've had quite the "baby boom" in our Farmers family. From January to June, we've added five new blessings to our family and are anxiously awaiting for two more by the end of the year!
